This half term we will be looking at answering the question;

'How and why do things change?'

Learning Quest topics:

- Science: We will be looking at plants, and even grow our own sunflowers.
- History: We will be looking at our families and the Royal family. We will look at how things have changed through time.
- <u>Geography:</u> We will be looking at using compasses and using a map to look at our local area.
- <u>Art and Design:</u> We will be designing and creating a model of our ideal pet.
- <u>Design Technology:</u> We will be planning and making a shoe box guinea pig hutch. Please get saving those shoe boxes!
- **<u>Computing:</u>** We will be creating our own Power Point informing someone how to look after a pet.

Reading

- Please read to and with your child for 10 minutes each day.
- Each child will be given a new book on Monday that can stay at home for the week and come back in on Fridays. They will then have a separate book to read in school.
- The children will be reading to adults in the week and also during guided reading.
- Please also rehearse those phonics, tricky words and high frequency words found in the passport.

Power of Reading

This half-term our Power of Reading book is called *'Olga da Polga'*.



<u>Maths</u>

• Remember to keep practicing the maths skills learnt in school at home. These can be anything from practicing counting in 2s, 5s, 10s, number bonds to baking a cake and weighing all the ingredients out.

Year 1s:

- You will begin learning about different measurements (length, height, weight and volume).
- We will then move on to learning different multiplication and division skills.

Year 2s:

• You will be learning about different properties of shapes, different fractions and then moving onto length and height.
