Learning Quest topics:

<u>Science</u>: We will be looking at the structure of different animals, what a microhabitat is, different weathers and what materials are the strongest.

<u>Geography</u>: We will be looking at the UK and its capitals. We will be learning about France and comparing it to England. We will also be looking at the human and physical features of France.

<u>Art and Design</u>: We will be looking at some artists work and then creating a similar piece of our own work. As well as this, we will be creating different tones, textures, and patterns through printing and drawing.

Design Technology: We will be doing some food technology, looking at building bridges as well as some dying techniques.

Computing: We will be creating our own Power Point informing someone about ants.

Reading

Please read to and with your child for 10 minutes each day.

Each child will be given a new book on Friday that can stay at home for the weekend and following week and come back in on Fridays. They will then have a separate book to read in school. The children will be reading to adults in the week and also during guided reading.

Please also rehearse those phonics, tricky words and high frequency words found in the passport.

Power of Reading

This half term our power of reading book is called 'The Bee Who Spoke'

Maths

Remember to keep practicing the maths skills learnt in school at home. This can be anything from practicing number bonds, halves and doubles, counting in different steps (up and down), times tables, telling the time, sharing a cake into $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{3}{4}$ or even finding shapes out and about.

Year 1s: You will be consolidating what you have learnt so far. You will be looking at numbers to 100 and their properties as well as learning new skills such as money and time.

Year 2s: You will be learning more in depth skills to help you when looking at the following; length and height, position and direction, time and mass, capacity and temperature.

This half-term we are looking into Christianity more including the life of s vicar and what happens in church on a Sunday. We will also be looking at the religion; Hinduism.
