#### School Meals Debt Policy

Please see the website for the revised School Meal Debt Policy. The School asks for payment in advance for school meals although we fully understand that occasionally this can be overlooked by busy parents. We have, however, had to review our school lunch debt policy in the light of the large amounts owing.

As a reminder:

- School meals should be paid for in advance by the Friday of the previous week.
- The School does not operate a payment in arrears system.
- Our debt policy allows a maximum of 5 meals to be owed (currently £11.00)
- We will continue to send a reminder letter home with pupils every week for any amounts owing.
- If arrears accumulate to more than 1 week (5 meals) of owed payments a second letter will be sent notifying parents that we <u>cannot continue to provide any further meals until the arrears are paid</u>.

Last Friday Hedgehog class had a fantastic Home Safety talk with Roy from Essex Fire Safety Team. They learnt about the importance of Smoke alarms and the important signs to look for to prevent a fire from happening at home. Badgers also enjoyed their Internet Safety workshop. They are aware of dangers when accessing the internet (through games, messaging and social media, etc) but are now aware of how to stay safe online and what to do if anything happens.
