



School Meals Debt Policy Reminder

The School asks for payment in advance for school meals although we fully understand that occasionally this can be overlooked by busy parents. We have, however, had to review our school lunch debt policy in the light of the large amounts owing.

- School meals should be paid for in advance by the Friday of the previous week.
- The School does not operate a payment in arrears system.
- Our debt policy allows a maximum of 5 meals to be owed (currently £11.00)
- We will send a reminder text every week for <u>any</u> amounts owing to keep you aware of your balance
- If arrears accumulate to more than 1 week (5 meals/£11.00) of owed payments a second text will be sent notifying parents that payment needs to be made as soon as possible.
- If arrears accumulate to more than 2 weeks (10 meals/£22.00) of owed payments we cannot continue to provide any further meals until the arrears are paid.
- Please contact the School Office if you are having any difficulties making payments.
