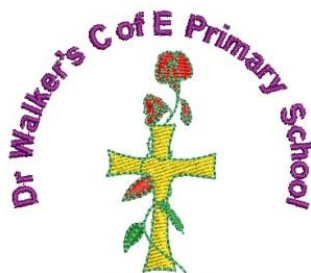

Show: What an amazing show! The children were enthusiastic and so funny. Well done to them all and a big thank you to the staff team for making it happen!

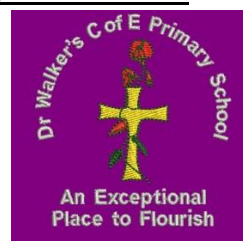
