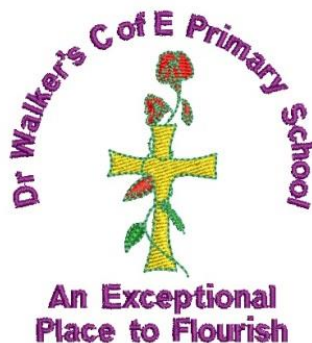

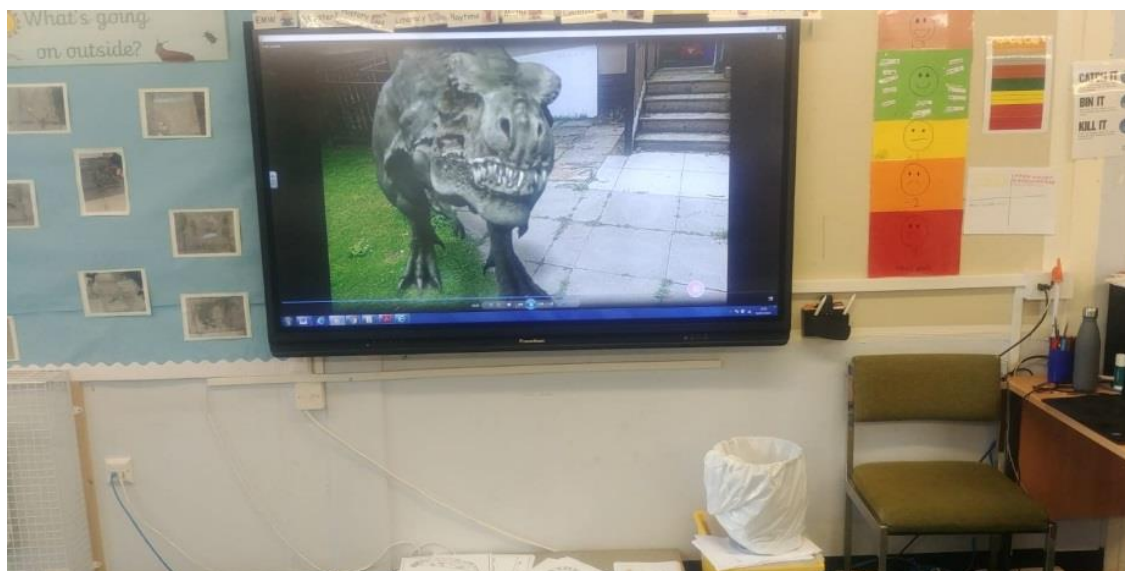

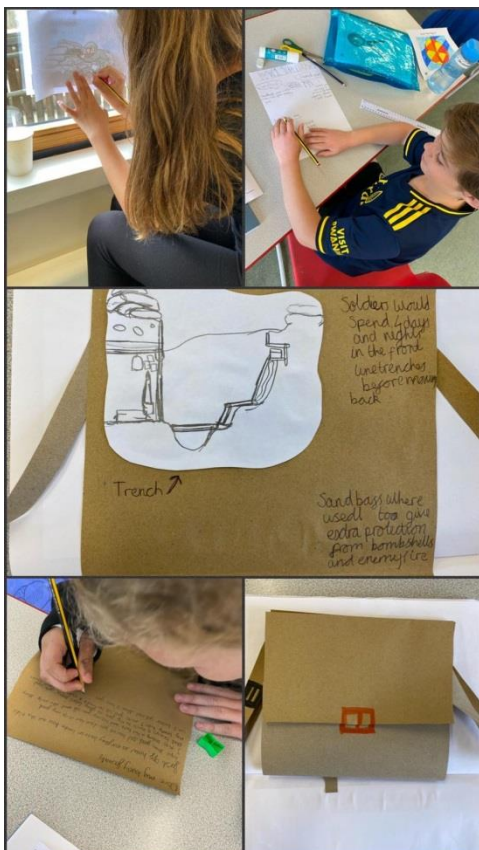
print to investigate when they got outside.

As we look towards next week, here is a reminder of our main RA points. The safety of the children, families and staff is our first concern and if we continue to all work together we can have another successful week.
