We began our week with our Easter Service at St Nicholas' Church and it was lovely to see so many family members join us. The children looked amazing in their Easter bonnets and Easter t-shirts and Rev. Sam Brazier-Gibbs brought along her special clergy wear, or vestments, that was 'willingly' modelled by one of our Year 6 children. Rev. Sam discussed the cassock, the long black cloak and the surplice, the white linen over-garment (that her son had often used if he was chosen as an angel in a school nativity). The beautifully embellished stoles were then shown – Green for Ordinary Special Times, Purple for Advent and Lent, Red for the Holy Spirit - Pentecost, White for major celebrations, such as Christmas and Easter – remembering God's Promise, and Black for funerals and loss. The children were delighted to hear how the vestments interlinked with the liturgical calendar.

We are excited to be part of the government's breakfast club early adopter scheme, which is funding universal breakfast clubs in up to 750 primary schools. From summer term 2025, free breakfast clubs will be available in early adopter schools, as part of a test and learn phase, so that the government can plan for a full national roll-out of universal breakfast clubs in primary schools.

As part of the offer, Dr Walker's will offer 30 minutes of childcare alongside a free breakfast. The club is open to all pupils from reception to Year 6. This will commence on **Tuesday 22nd April 2025**. More information will follow separately.
