


It is important that you access MCAS to book your child's lunch option ahead of the school day.

All school meals are cooked to order, and therefore, to avoid any further issues, we kindly ask that you begin to discuss lunch options with your child and book these **a week in advance**. All children in **Reception, Year 1, and Year 2** are legally entitled to receive hot school lunches at no cost under the Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) program. While these meals are automatically provided regardless of household income, parents must still book their child's specific meal choice in advance.


Lord,
